- Accessibility additions

- Installation of curb, gutter, storm sewer, lighting and bus turn-around points
- Installation of sidewalks

### Johnson Park Grandstand Updates

Estimated Cost: \$1,000,000\*

#### Importance to the Community

- Accessibility
- Improved facilities for local and regional athletic programs
- Spectator Experience
- Historical Field

Johnson Park athletic complex is considered a significant and historic regional athletic facility.

There is a need for improved safety, accessibility, efficiency and spectator experience improvements to the athletic complex.

Updates would include:

- 1) Expanded and renovated grandstand and seating areas
- 2) Accessibility improvements
- 3) Central concourse
- 4) Improved entrance
- 5) Plaza
- 6) Streetscape improvements
- 7) Dugout improvements

- Prioritize improvements that will support greater regional use of Johnson Park
